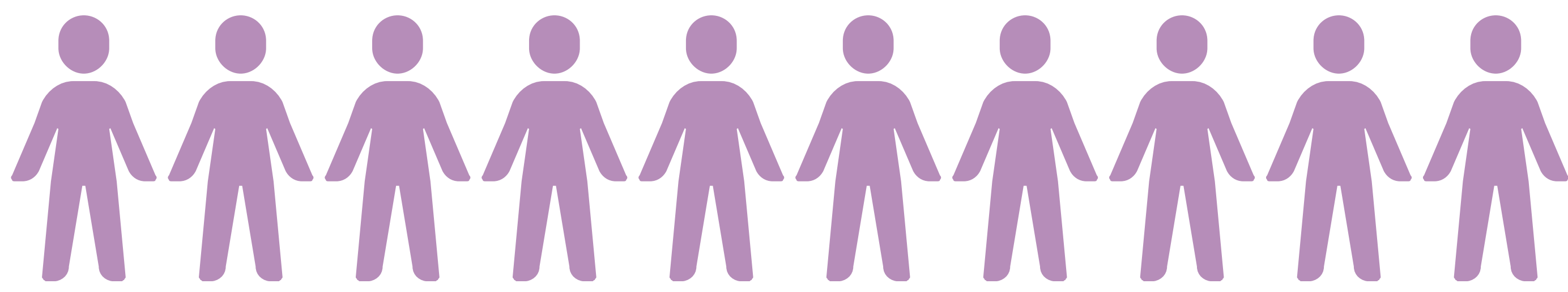
ECONOMIC IMPACT

Indiana's life sciences sector has a **\$102 Billion** Economic Impact on Indiana's economy



WORKFORCE

Indiana's Life Sciences Sector employs over **156,000 people** (70,000 direct employees)

More than **3,300** life sciences companies have a presence in Indiana.



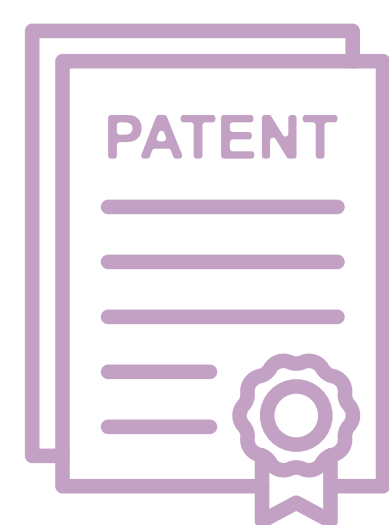
WAGES

PATENTS

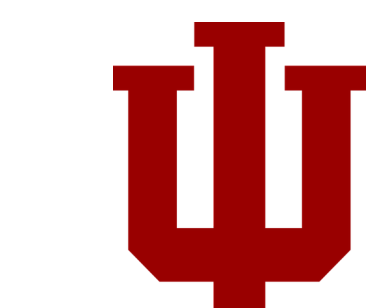
Indiana has a large volume of patents, with Hoosier inventors associated with **1,017 bioscience-related patents** issued in 2025.



SECTORS

Indiana sectors of health science excellence include:

Radiopharmaceuticals, Metabolic Disease, Cancer, Orthopedics, Regenerative Medicine, Neurologic Diseases, and Health Informatics.



Indiana is a research powerhouse with four Tier-1 research universities. In 2025, IU and Purdue each reported **\$1 Billion in research expenditures.**

EXPORTS

\$36 Billion - This made Indiana the **largest export state of life sciences goods in the United States** and the top exporter of pharmaceutical goods as of 2024.



EDUCATION

The Indiana University School of Medicine is the **largest research medical school in the country** with student enrollment of over **1,500** annually.



FUNDING

Indiana's Life Sciences Sector accessed over **\$192 Million** in venture funding for a total of **36** deals in 2025.
